



Case Study 1: Black Walnut Hedgerow, Mount Wolfe Farm

Date: Spring 2020

A double line of black walnut trees had been 'heeled-in' by Arnold Crandall in the late 1990s with the aim of replanting them throughout the farm, however the opportunity never came. With the permission of Arnold Crandall's daughters, now owners and managers of Mount Wolfe Farm, the black walnuts were layed using the South of England style in the Spring of 2020. Stakes were made of ash taken from around the farm and binders were willow kindly donated by the Jackson family.
